#### **The Project:**

The University of Nairobi – SASH Project is seeking to hire one (1) quality improvement nurse to undertake key activities of a project to provide vascular access that is appropriate and safe to neonates admitted to the Kenyatta National Hospital neonatal unit. Quality Improvement Nurse will work closely with the Principal Investigator and the Unit Quality Improvement Team to ensure that the project runs according to the quality improvement plan.

#### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

1. Participate in quality improvement training of neonatal unit staff
2. Champion implementation of the quality improvement project
3. Maintain a register of all participants included in the project.
4. Prepare and maintain good filing system (both the study participants and source verification documents) for all enrolled participants.
5. Collect accurate data and resolve any discrepancies with data team.
6. Prepare weekly, monthly and quarterly reports for the Principal Investigator

#### **Job Specifications:**

1. Kenya Registered Community Health Nurse.
2. Valid registration with relevant body.
3. Two (2) years of clinical experience post qualification
4. Training and experience in research, quality improvement and IT will have an added advantage.
